WORKS UPDATE

The project is approaching completion with the finishing trades working on all floors installing joinery, decorations and flooring. This includes parquet flooring to public areas and bespoke joinery to the bar and Library.

The testing and commissioning of all systems are progressing well.

Commission of lighting is in progress undertaking extensive electrical testing throughout the building, which will continue until the complete installation of the wiring and switches is finalised. This process aims to identify and rectify any potential connection issues. To facilitate this testing, the site lights have remained operational overnight for several weeks. Regrettably, it is not feasible to deactivate the site lights during this time, as doing so would also affect the emergency lighting system, thereby compromising safety and increasing the risk of accidents. We sincerely apologise for any disturbance this may cause and appreciate your understanding as we work diligently to ensure that the electrical systems function correctly. This testing is vital for guaranteeing the safety and reliability of the building's infrastructure. The lights will be turned off over the Christmas period.


LOOK AHEAD


The site will be open until 23rd December, and it will also be open on 29th and 30th December.

Regular hours will resume on 2nd January.

There will be 24/7 security in place starting this Friday, 19th December, until Monday morning, 5th January.

In January, work will continue towards completion. This includes paving the North Yard, installing planters along the Northern boundary of the site, and replacing the curbs on Arthur Street.
